It's Fall Meaning You Can Be Sure That Winter Is Not Far Behind

Remember the relief you felt when you thought winter was finally over, then yet another late spring snow hit in April with more snow, not taking into account all the other snow and ice we had all winter, especially in January and February! Chicago's total snowfall accumulation for 20-21 winter season was **48.8 inches**. Normally, the average is 33 inches for the year. Significant snowfall totals arrived in late January and continued to mid-February. With **21.9 inches of snow falling** in January 2021 making it the 10th snowiest January on record in Chicago according to the National Weather Service. February 2021 was the ninth snowiest February on record. For the month 21.6 inches fell, including a record daily snowfall of 6.1 inches on Feb. 15, Presidents' Day. Though none of these totals were enough to make the list of the area's Top 10 historic snowstorms. The first event was in late November which made it a long winter. There were smaller storms and there were worse ones that produced icing conditions throughout the winter and into early spring because of the cold temperatures we had. Salt shortages were again becoming a major issue at the end winter.

This last summer Northern Illinois has been in a severe drought situation some say the worst in 12 years. With the Dry weather we have had for 7 months will it continue into winter?? It's a roll of the dice what winter will bring' but be assured it is coming. The winter last year created a huge demand for salt which has depleted the stock piles in northern Illinois. To refill those salt piles has become increasing difficult due to the Pandemic, which we all have suffered through these last 18 months. That being said, all businesses including ours are suffering shortages of employees, raw materials for manufacturing, delays in shipping sometime weeks instead of days. As the salt companies can't find enough truckers to deliver their salt supplies, prices are increasing for these deliveries, and yes they are being passed on to the end users. We are paying more to get employees hired to drive plow trucks, and do sidewalk work. We have had to increase our wages to our employees to retain the ones we currently have with hopes this employment situation eases up.

The last winter was just plain ugly for you as well as us. Through it all we are proud to say not one of our customers was unable to access their property during or after snows hit. Deicing operations never stopped and properties were attended to as needed. We feel if nothing else we proved "when it snows we're there for you."

Communication Pledge:

At A.J.Services, we believe that communication is one of the keys to our success. Good communication allows us to perform the work to meet or exceed client expectations, and to address concerns before they become problems. When the weather is wintery, our clients can reach us 24 hours per day, so we can dispatch our plow and salt truck operators at any time there is a special need for our services. Storm Tracking and Reporting:

We rely on Continental Weather Service to confirm snowfall amounts for your area. Continental Weather is a private, impartial third party meteorological service that we subscribe to which tracks the storms and supplies us with time lines on when the snow will hit and what type of equipment we will need for the event. We have found that Continental Weather storm reports are more accurate than that of newspaper snow reporting, where accumulation amounts are often estimated or imprecise. Maybe it snowed 3" at O'Hare Airport, but in your area the amounts recorded could be much less. Our customers know that they can rely on accurate billing from A.J Services that is based upon actual measured snow depths in their area. A storm summary of the event is included with all of our invoices.

Lowering Your Exposure to Potential Litigation:

Much of the reason ice control services have become popular is the lessening of liability to the property owners. One study from the University Of North Carolina Highway Safety Research Center revealed that 37 percent of patients admitted to hospitals for pedestrian-related accidents were injured on icy surfaces.
